## Doctor's Notes



Day to day routines have changed rather drastically for many of us during the COVID-19 pandemic, and many of us eagerly await the return of our "old normal". However, some changes have occurred during this time of emergency may have lasting positive effects on society in general and healthcare in particular.

One of these changes is the expansion and widespread adoption of telehealth, or telemedicine services. Telehealth/telemedicine is the use of technology such as computers and/or smart phones to allow a physician or other healthcare provider to visit with a patient remotely.
